"Issues" (challenges & opportunities) identified related to the capture of "road parcels" AWG Participants recommended an info session to explore what "roads" are in ParcelMap BC

Highways & Roads Discovery Exercise (2018)

A deep-dive workshopping of the state of the spatial inventory of lands designated for highways & roads Led by LTSA including MoTI, MFLNRORD, City of Surrey, ABCLS Produced a definition of the "problem" and a series of high-level solution steps

On Compilation, in regular Operations and Special Projects



Highways & Roads: What do we mean?

Defining Statutes

Criteria

- Legally designated a "highway", "street" or "public road" with ownership/tenure defined by statute
- 2. Legally surveyed with the survey plan filed in the land title register or Crown land registry (*except for historical practices*)

Transportation Act	Highway and Arterial Highway	Defines Highways and Arterial Highways Defines Highway creation processes Highways in rural areas and Arterial Highways are owned by MOTI
Community Charter <u>Municipal Act</u> (1979- 1991) <u>Municipal Clauses (1906 -</u> historic)	Highway	Defines municipal (non-provincial) highways other than in the City of Vancouver, Highways within municipalities, other than arterial highways are owned by the local governments
Vancouver Charter	Highway (Street)	Defines Street creation process within the City of Vancouver, Streets within the City of Vancouver are owned by the City
Land Act	Public Road	Defines Public Road creation process over untitled Crown Land, Public Roads are under the jurisdiction of MFLNRORD
Land Title Act	Highway	Defines how highways interact with Titles in Land Title Register




Highways & Roads in ParcelMap BC

Current Practice

Almost all legal sources that establish Highways & Roads used are persisted in records at the LTSA

The ParcelMap BC operations framework captures the spatial extent and basic attribution for surveyed Highway & Roads in the ParcelMap BC parcel fabric.

B plans – if conditions met these may simply be considered as <i>Land Title</i> <i>Act</i> plans or its predecessor	LTR	No – Back capture only



Types of Roads, Historical vs. Current Completeness

Road Dedications

- E.g. Section 107 of the Land Title Act 'Road Dedication'.
- Adding any <u>new</u> Road Dedication on a submitted LTA or LA Plan into ParcelMap BC.
- Historic representation is mostly absent with a few exceptions, e.g. VIP76046 added during compilation of ParcelMap BC.





'Titled Roads'

- Roads with an Active PID in the LTSA Land Title Register.
- Currently integrating ~33 000, originally excluded from the build of ParcelMap BC.
- Not all of these will be classed as 'Road'.
- Anticipate completion by March, 2023. Currently have **24000** integrated into the fabric.



Types of Roads, Historical vs. Current Completeness

Other Roads: Strata Roads, Private Roads,

Private Lanes, etc.

- Strata Roads defined on a Bareland Strata will be represented as Common Property in ParcelMap BC.
- We do not map Common Property for Building Stratas.

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• Private roads, driveways, etc., are not mapped in ParcelMap BC.





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MoTI Highway Records

- Delineated on a Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure Highways (MoTI) Highway Plan.
- Or Highway Plan filed in LTSA's Land Title Register.


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


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Attribute Signatures for Road Dedications

- Parcel Name = Name of Road Dedication on Survey Plan
 - E.g. Dedicated Lane will be named 'Lane', 'Walkway', 'FSR', 'Road', 'Arterial Highway', etc.
- Parcel Class = <u>Road</u>
- PID and PIN = <null>

* No unique ID in the Land Title Register to track Road parcels dedicated on LTA or LA plans. From an induvial records perspective they effectively 'die' on the Survey Plan.







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
Attribute Signatures for Road Dedications

Ownertype:

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- If dedication is an Arterial Highway it will be ٠ Crown Provincial or Crown Agency (if verified the owner is a Crown Agency).
- Road Dedications in Municipalities will be ٠ owned by the Municipality.
- Road Dedications outside a Municipality will ٠ be owned by the Crown or Crown Provincial.

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
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Attribute Signatures for Road Dedications

- No PID so no Full Legal Description and Designation Fields will be <null>.
- Plan Record will be the dedicated LTA or LA Plan Number.

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Strata & Other Private Roads

Strata Roads defined on a Bareland Strata will be represented as Common Property in ParcelMap BC.

We do not map Common Property for Building Stratas.

Private roads, Private laneways, driveways, are not mapped in ParcelMap BC.




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Titled Roads: Special Project for Back Capture Background

- During PMBC build, active PIDs identified as 'road' through assessment by LTSA were excluded under the premise that they would be mapped later. A back capture project seeks to represent those PIDs in ParcelMap BC.
- Revaluating how we class 'titled roads' with our colleagues in the Land Title Office by looking at the notation on title in greater detail.




- Some legal instruments may result in the creation of a new titled road parcel:
 - The Vancouver Charter and Community Charter.
 - Section 99 Ref Plans create an Interest which is later granted a parcel (PID) in the Register.



Titled Roads

Attribute Signatures for Titled Road Parcels

- Parcel Name = PID value
- Parcel Class = Road
- PID = PID value
- Ownertype derived from Ownership on Title related to the Parcel record in the Land Title Register
- The Legal Description derived from the Land Title Register for the Parcel Record
- Designation Fields are populated
- Plan Record is the dedicated LTA Plan.





MoTI Highway Records: Special Project

Background

 Working with MoTI to create a spatial inventory of Highways under the purview of MoTI and Transporation Act instruments.

•Records attributed thus far that we want to generate a spatial inventory of:

- •~15,000, with another ~20,000 potentially in scope
- Plans filed with the Land Title Office will be included in ParcelMap BC:
 - •roughly ~8,000 identified so far.
 - •'back capture' entries into ParcelMap BC follow the attribution signature outlined earlier


MoTI Highway Records: Special Project

What is included in ParcelMap BC?

•Road Survey Plans (RS Plans) filled at the Ministry (MoTI) are georeferenced and compiled along with the accompanying Gazette information.

- •MoTI Plan Shape (Road Survey Plan)
- •Gazetted Highways
- •Closed Highway
- Parent Parcel Acquisition

- These types of plan filings:
 - attributed representation in MoTI Project pertaining to their needs (gazette information).
 - an entry in ParcelMap BC following the attribution specifications outlined earlier.
