



Updates & Outcomes from June 9th Sub-Group meeting:

Discussion circled around a few themes:

Lots of good discussion & findings to date but not much shared outside the AWG

Related Issues raised but not many Resolved - hard to pin down what to do

Involving BCA a natural fit for this data integration

Topics worthy of more work:

Understanding of BCA workflows: Assessment Fabric and JUROL creation

Documenting commonalities in Local Government workflows: Integrating land records / tracking with unique identifiers

Possibility of "Tempest Integration Training" workshop with CentralSquare

Communicate findings to broader Local Government community more effectively

Brief History – Highways & Roads Discovery Report (December 2018):

Current Practice

Almost all legal sources that establish Highways & Roads are records at the LTSA

ParcelMap BC captures the spatial extent and basic attribution for surveyed Highway & Roads on a go-forward

Several flavours of historic Highways & Roads records are not depicted in ParcelMap BC

Target

Incremental back-capture of historic surveys that may be Highways & Roads

Titled Roads: Historic back-capture of these "missing PIDs":

Active Road Parcels Project -- Background:

During the build of PMBC, active PIDs that were identified as 'road' through assessment by the LTSA were excluded under the premise that they would be mapped later. This project seeks to represent those PIDs in ParcelMap BC that were initially excluded.

Scope:

PID initially excluded from PMBC build;

PID is active in the Land Title Register;

Exclusion comment or reason for exclusion references a road;

The marginal notes indicates that the parcel may be a road;

PMBC Operations can verify through other sources (i.e. imagery) that the parcel may overlap what appears to be road or ascertain through the parcels Legal Description that it may be road.




Titled Road Parcel Attribute Signature Notes:

- Detailed Roads Signatures Document prepared, reviewed and approved by multiple divisions at the LTSA providing the team with 'rules' to follow during interpretation / integration.
- Geometry Source will be PMBC Compilation where old Survey Plans are referenced otherwise likely ICF, ICI Society if a suitable shape was found there.
- Legal Description, PID value, Municipality, Regional District, Ownertype, Designations will be derived through data in the Land Title Register like every other parcel with an Active PID.
- Estimated Error values on the parcel / points will be updated using LTSA tools.
- Preserve the higher accuracy parcel data in all cases when integrating the titled roads.
- Parcels will reference the Survey Plan Number deposited in the Land Title Register.
- <u>Important</u>: Parcel Class will be <u>Subdivision</u> if Ownertype is Private or Mixed regardless of if the marginal notes indicates it is a Road or it appears to be a Road. All others will be Roads.




Titled Roads Project Projections:

Integrate these historic plans into ParcelMap BC Parcel Fabric Analysis:

6989 Plans Currently Identified as Road or Highway in ASTRA Integration Plan:

'Best Fit' approach (preserve more accurate data) Fit existing Spatial data into the Parcel Fabric

Sources:

Existing Spatial Layer: <u>TANTALIS – Temporary Transportation</u> Survey Plans filed at the LTSA
