

## PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #26 Summary Notes March 17, 2021 – 10:00am to 12:00pm – Web Meeting

### Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. AWG Membership:**  
New members: Cara Foden from City of Port Alberni is participating in the AWG as an observer and may consider joining.  
Departing members: Kenna Bilek from MoTI. Brian Greening thanked Kenna on behalf of the group for her contributions to, and participation in, the AWG.
- 2. Communications Update:** The target for subscription level for the PMBC Newsletter have now been met. AWG members who have not already subscribed can do so at:

- 3. Team Alignment:** “Data Alignment Workflows” Workshop: LTSA are looking at options for participating in the Interior GIS Users’ Group (IGISUG) to present the DAWp this summer and are coordinating w/Esri Canada to plan a future full-length workshop focussed on the Alignment Tools. The City of Kamloops have worked with the DAWp to align their historical ROW data. LTSA will be assessing the results and will present the findings to the AWG.  
  
**ACTION ITEM:** Provide an update of Kamloops’ experience with the DAWp and how it will be communicated at AWG #27. – **LTSA**
- 4. Team Land Records:** No specific activity on the part of Team Land Records since the last AWG. Some resources have been added to the ICI Society Forum related to linking PMBC with Tempest. CentralSquare have been asked to provide a proposal related to supporting a Land Records workshop with specific Tempest / Vadim content.
- 5. Team Province:** No significant changes / activities since the last AWG. A working group will likely be formed soon to pursue next steps around ICF retirement / adoption of PMBC.
- 6. ParcelMap BC Operations:** Recent transaction volumes have been consistent with other years at this time. Recently completed areas of Spatial Improvement include Beaverdell, Savona, Waneta, Fruitvale, Cowichan Station, CVRD Part 2 and Naramata. Targeted areas currently include CVRD, North Oliver, South Oliver, West Vancouver, Rossland and Golden.
- 7. Adopter Status Update:** Total number of organisations that have Adopted is currently 78. Newly Adopted organisations include North Coast Regional District, Central Coast Regional District, Village of Port Clements and the Village of Masset.

8. ICI Society Virtual Café “PMBC Deep Dive” Summary: A PMBC “Deep Dive” session was conducted Feb 24<sup>th</sup> with over 130 attendees.

A post-workshop poll was conducted to get attendee feedback: 26 responses (20% response rate). A summary of the poll results was presented to the group.

Poll highlights:

- Attendees generally happy with the session (4.2/5 average rating).
- Various topics covered during the session had broad appeal to attendees.
- Adoption Resources and Additional Control Point Submission were of particular interest to attendees.
- Interest in future workshops on Alignment Tools and Land Records Integration was confirmed.

9. Adopter Issues Log: Issues in the Issues Log with a Priority of “High” and Status of “In Progress” were reviewed to assess where such items may be moved forward toward resolution.

Tempest Integration: Issues 34/48/49: Several members of the AWG have successfully implemented approaches (e.g. using SQL views). The AWG could draw on this experience/knowledge to support a future Land Records workshop to augment/substitute for involvement by CentralSquare.

**ACTION:** Monitor situation and solicit support from AWG members (Whistler, Sooke, Harterra) as needed. – **Team Land Records / LTSA**

10. Implementation Partner Program Review: The current status of the Implementation Partner Program was reviewed, and it was suggested that the original Terms of Reference may no longer align with the current scope, mandate and responsibilities of Implementation Partners and LTSA.
