PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #27 Summary Notes April 21, 2021 – 10:00am to 12:00pm – Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. <u>Communications Update</u>: The first PMBC Newsletter was released on April 20. AWG members who have not already subscribed can do so at: <u>https://ltsa.ca/contact-us/subscribe-to-ltsa-communications/#</u>
- <u>Team Alignment</u>: LTSA is coordinating a presentation to the Interior GIS Users' Group (IGISUG) on June 1, 2021 are coordinating w/Esri Canada to plan a subsequent fulllength workshop on June 24, 2021 focussed on the Alignment Tools. The City of Kamloops and the Township of Langley will be providing highlights of their experiences to date with the DAWp at the June 1 session.
- 3. <u>Team Land Records</u>: A Land Records Integration Workshop will be conducted on May 19, 2021 in place of the regular AWG Working Session. Members of the AWG will primarily be responsible for contributing content and LTSA/ICI Society will coordinate inputs and facilitate the session.

ACTION ITEM: Begin promotion of the May 19 Land Records Integration Workshop Virtual Café ASAP. – **ICI Society / LTSA**

ACTION ITEM: Coordinate workshop inputs and facilitate the session. – LTSA / ICI Society

- 4. <u>Team Province</u>: The Provincial ICF Retirement Working Group recently met internally. The key issue continues to be owner classifications on untitled parcels.
- ParcelMap BC Operations: Recent transaction volumes have been very high. The Defect Rate is currently hovering around the 5% mark. Recently completed areas of Spatial Improvement include CVRD, Naramata and North Oliver. Targeted areas currently include South Oliver, Rossland and Golden. Two new parcel mapping technicians will start at LTSA in May. Active Road Parcels: Work is on track to meet the projected completion date of March 2022.
- <u>Adopter Status Update</u>: Total number of organisations that have Adopted is currently 81. Newly Adopted organisations include Prince Rupert Port Authority, LTSA (SGD & LTO).
- 7. <u>LTSA Projects, Products & Services Update:</u> A number of new initiatives or product/service enhancements are currently in progress at LTSA.

- a. Migration of ParcelMap BC services "to the Cloud" Go Live scheduled for April 25.
- b. Historic Highways project has kicked-off with MoTI.
- c. Survey Plan Services Modernization: Plan Submission Alignment moving to more agile approach to product and services development.
- d. Pilot / PoC is underway with Kamloops to include Historic Interest Parcels. Hoping to roll the approach out to other LGs over time.
- e. LMFG follow up w/ City of Vancouver: Update Workflow Options Discovery with the Survey Department exploring alternatives to parcel fabric maintenance using updates from PMBC follow up planned for May.
- 8. <u>ICI Society Operations Update:</u> The Society's AGM is scheduled for April 29, 2021. A Virtual Café focussed on Utilities is being planned (likely to occur in late May).
- 9. <u>AWG Member Engagement:</u> An updated version of the Adopter Checklist was presented by LTSA. Looking to get a more accurate picture of where are the various AWG members are in terms of Adoption Status? Why are they at that stage? What is the underlying motivation for participation in the AWG? What do AWG members want to contribute to / get from the group?

A survey will be developed to explore some of the above items and look at alternative models going forward (e.g. breakout rooms for sub-groups, more interaction vs. simply "reporting out").

Suggestions from the group included asking AWG members to nominate agenda topics and increased use of video to allow members to have more "contact".

ACTION ITEM: Develop survey addressing the above questions for AWG members to respond to. – **LTSA**

ACTION ITEM: Solicit input for future AWG agendas from members proactively. - **LTSA**

 Implementation Partners: Harterra reported that they are encountering challenges associated with developing literacy with certain clients regarding PMBC and how to lever / exploit PMBC vs. having their own parcel fabric / property lines data set. Smaller communities tend to "do it their own way".

Potential workshop topic: Best practices for using survey/parcel data in real-world workflows. Subtopics may include accuracy, fitness for use, etc.

ACTION ITEM: Further explore the idea of conducting a workshop on this topic in the Fall of 2021. – **LTSA / AWG Members**
