PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #30 Notes (Draft) September 22, 2021 – 10:00am to 12:00pm – Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. <u>Communications Update</u>: The September PMBC Newsletter was just released. AWG members who have not already subscribed can do so at: <u>https://ltsa.ca/contact-us/subscribe-to-ltsa-communications/#</u>
- 2. <u>Team Alignment</u>: A full-length workshop entitled "Deep Dive into Data Alignment with ParcelMap BC" was held on June 24, 2021. A new DAWp version (1.1) was also released, which includes increased automation, enhancements and new tutorial content.
- 3. <u>Team Land Records</u>: No specific updates since the last AWG session from Team Land Records.
- 4. <u>Team Province</u>: Administrative Boundaries Management System is exploring using the DAWp for Administrative Boundary Alignment. An ICF Retirement Issues workshop (focussing on Owner Types / Data Model gaps) has been proposed. LTSA will lead this workshop with involvement from GeoBC and DataBC. John Antill is returning to GeoBC after a extended secondment.
- <u>Adopter Status Update</u>: Total number of organisations that have Adopted remains at 83. There has been some movement over the summer with Adopters moving to the Transitioning stage (e.g. CRD). Discussions are occurring with the City of Chilliwack to provide them access to PMBC.
- 6. <u>Adopter Issues Log</u>: Several issues (35, 48, 49, 54, 59, 60) were confirmed as "Resolved":

In progress: Issue #38: Crown Ownership – Owner Type is currently identified as crown, if crown on title. Untitled crown land is not statused. LTSA proposing "None" Owner Type label changes to "Untitled Crown".

7. <u>AWG Format Review:</u> The Terms of Reference for the AWG have been revised and are available on Basecamp. The key proposed changes to the TOR are around AWG Roles and AWG Meeting format and schedule. AWG Steering Committee meetings will be scheduled quarterly instead of monthly. Current AWG members will be asked to confirm their intent to remain involved and will be asked to nominate candidates for new AWG Steering Committee members.

ACTION ITEM: AWG Facilitation Team to develop a survey (including a link to the revised TOR) to confirm AWG membership going forward and to share the results at the next AWG Steering Committee meeting. – **LTSA**
