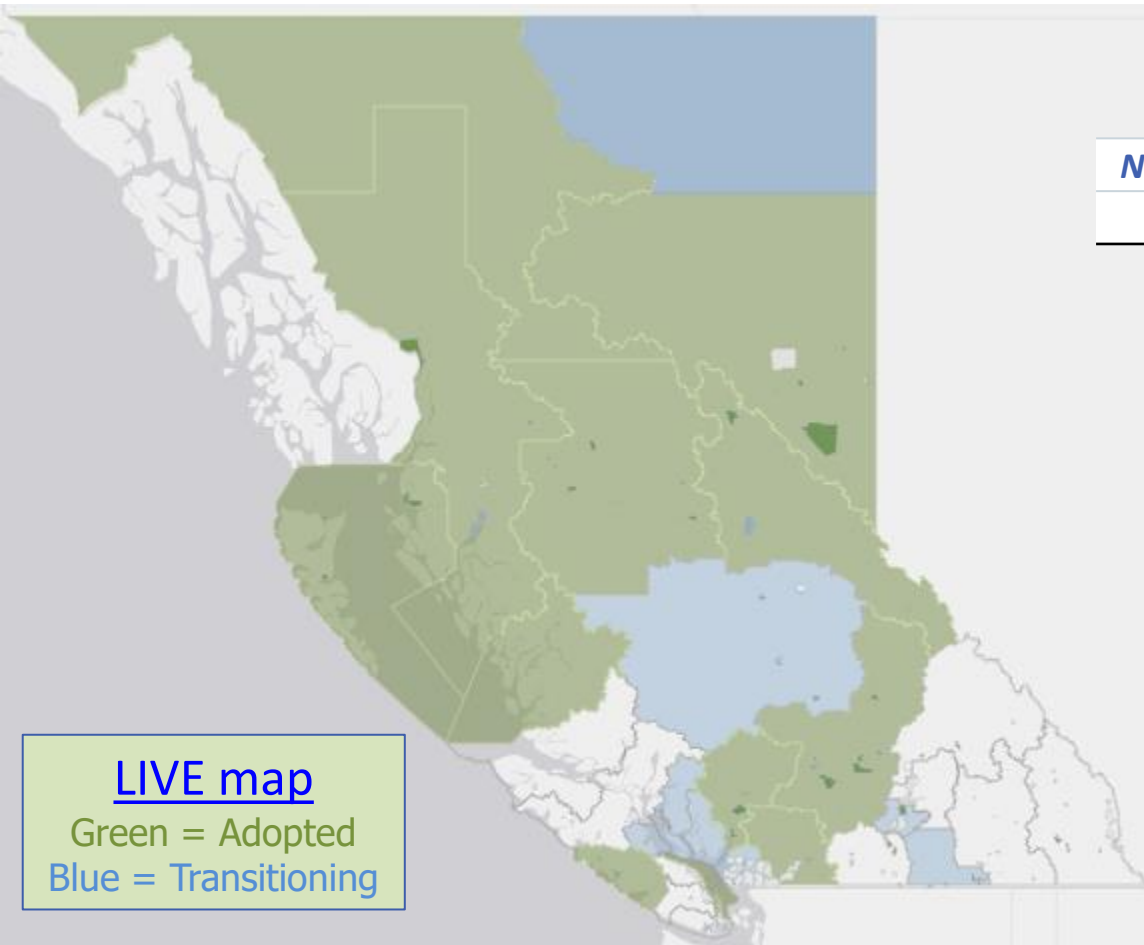

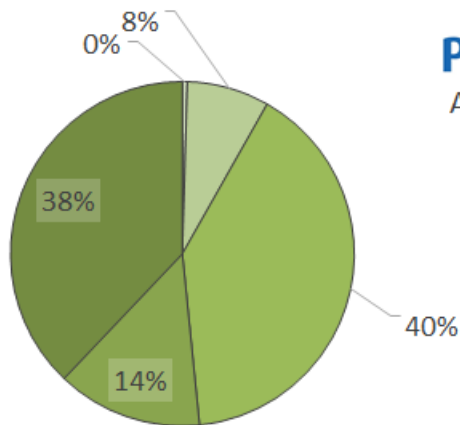

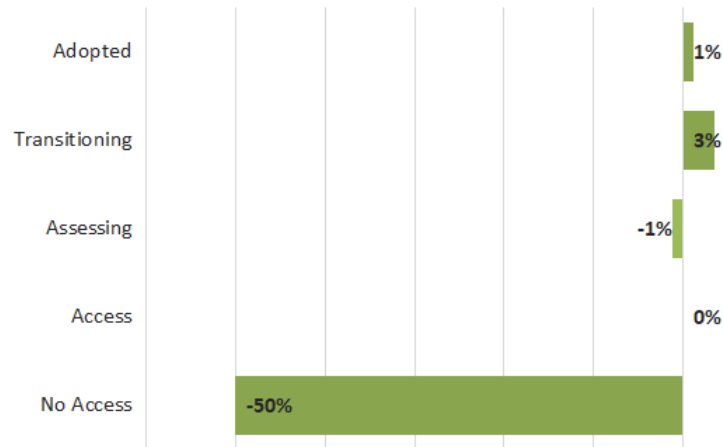

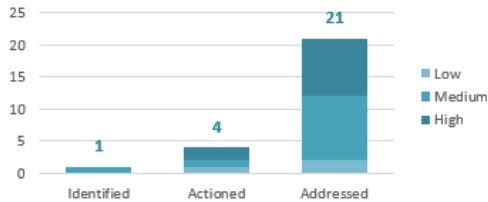

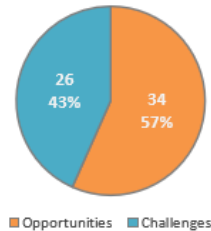

State of **Challenges** by Priority

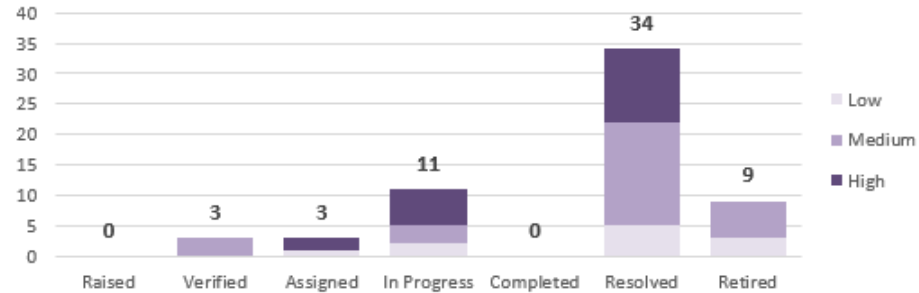

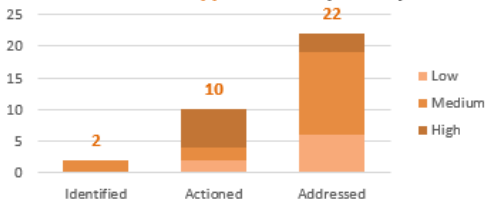
Adopter Issues Summary

# AWG Format Review:

## Survey Review: Terms of Reference and AWG Structure

### Key Changes -- Roles:

#### Participants & Facilitators plus Greater Adopter Community

**Participants:** Individual AWG participants have the following responsibilities:

- Understand and represent the interests of the Adopter organization and group they represent, along with any relevant ParcelMap BC-related opportunities for their organization or barriers to ParcelMap BC adoption.
- Actively participate in AWG Steering Committee Sessions through attendance, discussion, and review of minutes, and other AWG-related documents.
- Regularly contribute content to AWG Sponsored Sessions via presentations or demonstrations related to ParcelMap BC adoption.
- Individual members shall represent, or act as a proxy for, peer organizations by tabling Issues that are of common interest to a particular Adopter Group.
- Take a genuine interest in the AWG's outcomes and overall success.

**Facilitators:** AWG facilitators have the following responsibilities:

- Prepare and distribute meeting agendas and related meeting materials in advance of each meeting, including Steering Committee and Sponsored sessions.
- Assist AWG Participants in articulating issues, barriers and opportunities in an actionable way.
- Coordinate AWG member contributions to, and participation in AWG Sponsored Sessions and related Adoption Resources.
- Ensure that AWG meetings are efficient and productive through exercising effective facilitation skills to ensure meeting agenda goals are achieved in the allocated time.
- Clearly and succinctly summarize AWG meeting minutes, decisions and actions.



# AWG Format Review:

## Survey Review: Terms of Reference and AWG Structure

### Key Changes -- AWG Meetings:

Sponsored Sessions, Steering Committee Sessions, Facilitator Sessions

#### AWG Steering Committee Meetings

Quarterly AWG Steering Committee meetings will typically be held at "hub" locations in Metro Vancouver (LTSA offices in Vancouver or New Westminster) and Victoria (LTSA offices)\*. The goal will be to gather as many AWG members as possible together in the hub locations; however, people who are not able to attend in person can participate via Web meeting / video conference. If warranted, a 3rd hub in Kamloops (LTSA offices) or elsewhere might also be utilised. An AWG facilitator will typically be present for the sessions at each location. Quarterly AWG meetings will typically be scheduled to last 2 hours. A recurring agenda item for AWG Steering Committee Meetings will be a review and update of the AWG Issues Log which is used to track opportunities and challenges associated with ParcelMap BC adoption.

#### AWG Sponsored Sessions

Between quarterly AWG Steering Committee meetings, additional AWG Sponsored sessions will be conducted that are targeted broadly to the Adopter Community. The primary focus of these sessions will be outreach and information dissemination to ParcelMap BC Adopters and may be focussed on one or more of the ParcelMap BC Adopter Groups identified above. These sessions will typically be conducted workshop style, utilizing the ICI Society's "Virtual Café" format or in conjunction with Adopter Group related user conferences. The timing and cadence of these sessions will be determined based on demand from the Adopter Community and the availability of appropriate resources to support the sessions.

#### AWG Facilitator Meetings

Regular meetings will be conducted among the core team of AWG Facilitators (composed of representatives from the LTSA and the ICI Society) for the purposes of planning and coordinating AWG-related activities and maintaining a current version of the ParcelMap BC Adoption Issues Log. The AWG Facilitators will also act as liaison between the AWG and the larger Adopter Community to support outreach and awareness of AWG activities, outcomes and related adoption-related resources.
