

PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #31 Summary Notes December 8, 2021 – 10:00am to 12:00pm – Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

1. New ICI Society Personnel: Brian Greening and Steve Mark introduced Eden McDonald-Yale to the AWG. Eden has joined the Society as the new Stakeholder Engagement Coordinator.
2. Team Alignment: The Administrative Boundaries Management System Team at GeoBC continues to work with Esri Canada to apply the Alignment Toolkit to support boundary alignment with ParcelMap BC. This work is resulting in some revised workflows to better support very large datasets / geographic areas.
3. Team Land Records: Brian Goble at Sooke has plans to migrate the ParcelMap BC / Tempest scripts to FME, but no firm timeline has been set.
4. Team Province: A Provincial Focus Group / ICF Retirement Workshop was held on November 10. Key outcomes were:
 - a. ICF is now using PMBC for shapes, but not attributes yet.
 - b. ICF Retirement centred on resolving Owner Type labels and developing a data model which is an "ICF Container for ParcelMap BC".
5. Adopter Status Update: 86 organisations have now formally Adopted ParcelMap BC. New adopters since the last AWG meeting are qathet RD, District of Elkford and the BC Oil & Gas Commission. The OGC intend to publish an industry bulletin encouraging use of ParcelMap BC.
6. Activities Since AWG #30: A number of activities occurred AWG #30 (September 22, 2021) and AWG #31. Highlights include:
 - a. A Transition Planning Workshop was held October 20, 2021
 - b. A Survey Data Workshop was held November 17, 2021
 - c. Attendees to both workshops came from a broader range of organisations than previous AWG-related sessions.
 - d. A Utilities Focus Group Workshop is planned for December 15. A subset of participants will be the subject of a "deep dive" situation assessment similar to what was done with the LMFG.
7. Adopter Issues Log: 60 issues have been raised overall since the inception of the AWG. 17 remain active. The 17 remaining active issues were reviewed in terms of current status. Many of the items are the subject on ongoing work toward resolution.
8. Future AWG Activities: The following future AWG activities / focus areas were identified:

- a. "Using ParcelMap BC Change Products": A workshop contrasting the Real World Changes vs. Change Vectors, including what they are and how are they used. There currently appears to be confusion about the two products and how to use them.
- b. "Roads Features in ParcelMap BC": A workshop on the Roads project currently in progress. How these roads will appear in ParcelMap BC? What will be mapped versus what will be left out?
- c. "Historical Interests in ParcelMap BC": A workshop on the alignment of historical interests with Parcel Map BC.
