

PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #32 Summary Notes March 30, 2022 - 10:00 to 11:30am - Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. <u>Activities Since AWG #31</u>: Since AWG #31 (December 2021) three workshops were hosted by LTSA/ICI Society:
 - a. Utilities Focus Group Discovery Workshop December 15, 2021 26 attendees.
 - b. Highways and Roads in ParcelMap BC Virtual Café February 3, 2022 105 attendees.
 - c. Temporal Changes in ParcelMap BC March 2, 2022 23 attendees.

A fourth workshop – "Interest Parcels in ParcelMap BC" is scheduled for April 6, 2021 – 70 attendees signed up so far.

- 2. <u>Team Alignment</u>: Work is continuing between Esri Canada and GeoBC to operationalise the DAWp Province-wide.
- 3. <u>Team Province:</u> Alignment of Owner Type labels is being finalised with the Province. The "ICF-like" Container for ParcelMap BC" is currently being developed to support operational retirement of the ICF.
- 4. <u>Adopter Status Update</u>: 94 organisations have now formally Adopted ParcelMap BC. This number is expected to increase significantly once the ICF is retired.
- 5. <u>Three Year AWG Recap</u>: A three-year retrospective of the AWG was presented highlighting key milestones and achievements of the group since its formation in September 2018.
- 6. What's Next for the AWG?: Highlights of the approach for the AWG going forward include:
 - a. <u>Meeting Format & Cadence</u>: AWG Steering Committee meetings will be held quarterly and will be shorter (typically 60-90 minutes). A "consent agenda" approach will be used to efficiently table items for group input and approval.
 - b. <u>Issues/Issues Log</u>: The AWG will continue to work toward the resolution of remaining issues. Remaining issues will also serve as inputs to LTSA's Products & Services Roadmap, and progress toward issue resolution will be reported to the AWG regularly.
 - c. <u>Ideas/Priorities for Future AWG Activities</u>: The AWG will continue to provide key ideas and priorities for future activities such as workshops and other initiatives associated with ParcelMap BC product and services enhancements.
