


## **Adopter Dashboard: February 28th 2022 Footprint**



## **Background – ParcelMap BC Adoption Strategic Plan**


 "Strategic Plan for Adoption of ParcelMap BC by Participating Stakeholders" completed in 2018.


## **Adoption Working Group Key Facts**







## Framework Metrics – AWG Issues Log

#### Status Breakdown of Issues (AWG Review)





### GSS Portfolio: Product Sustainment & New Initiatives

#### **Key Activities:**

#### Team now has 2 Product Owners!!!

Portfolio responsibilities split across 2 core product lines

New epic-based roadmapping & reporting (incl. capacity allocation & prioritization) starting next month!

#### Core Customer Applications (PFM, PMSS, PMD & SPS)

ATM Breakout for GSS is complete!!!!! In PROD with 22.3.1 on March 6<sup>th</sup> – Opens up the Sustainment backlog...

Roadmaps & sprint planning to start dedicating minimum Dev capacity to "Sustainment" – 20% target

ArcGIS Pro Migration ("PFM Modernization") – Scoping project completing and planning for prototype in development COMPASS 1.1 -- Phase 2 enhancements in Development

#### ParcelMap BC Enhancements (i.e. Data Product Enhancements)

Titled Roads back-capture project

Progressing well and forecast completion FY22/23 – Approximately 75% complete of ~32000 PIDs

Highways Records Mapping (Project with MoTI)

Extended for FY 22/23. New WebApp to facilitate triage. Exploring an index map approach to get more value sooner!

Interest Parcel Submission Program (aka Historic Interests Intake PoC with Kamloops)

PoC compete, specifications underway to Dev into an operational program. Workshop on Interest Parcels on April 6<sup>th</sup>

Addition of Vertical Benchmarks as new control type in ParcelMap BC Control Points

Specifications complete and readying for Dev now that GSS ATM Breakout essentially done – targeting May release

Owner Type re-labeling for "None" and "Unknown" types

Driven by Province for ICF Retirement – Finalizing labels with GeoBC. Specs ready & Dev on standby...

### GSS Portfolio: Product Sustainment & New Initiatives

#### **Key Activities:**

#### **Spatial Improvement Assessment (SIA) application**

Roadmapping some significant enhancements for Summer/Fall while maintain monthly publication of fresh assessments

#### **<u>Data Alignment Workflow package</u>** (DAWp) tools

Engaged Esri Canada to support GeoBC with ABMS alignment pilot & other province-wide scope operationalization Additional enhancements proposed but in backlog pending customer feedback

#### **Survey Plan Services Modernization**

Step 1: Plan Submission Alignment – Dev underway on Release 1 iteration for Plan Workspace v1.0 release Fall 2022

Step 2: Proposed Parcels – Work starting Fall 2022 on solutioning (working dependencies with PFM Modernization and UPI!)

#### First Nations National Land Registry (with the Lands Advisory Board)

A new land registry for Framework Agreement First Nations – Proposal complete and now in detailed Solution Definition

#### Plan Preview service

Working with Policy (define permitted uses) and Statutory (support internal records access) to define requirements for a modernized service
