




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# **Recap: AWG Goals & Objectives**

### The Goals of the AWG:

"... serve as a forum for adopter organisations to communicate with LTSA and the ICI Society concerning identification and resolution of barriers challenges to the adoption of ParcelMap BC in their organization."

#### and

"... serve as a means of identifying and facilitating and/or prioritizing the development of value-added products and services that the LTSA, ICI Society or others may provide to adopter organisations to enhance the value of ParcelMap BC over the longer term."

### Objective is to promote Adoption, where:

"ParcelMap BC is recognized and used as the authoritative cadastral parcel fabric representation in BC, spatially and for accompanying attribution, by the Adopter organizations, which include local governments and major utilities in the Province, among others."



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# **Review:** Facilitator & Participant Roles and Expectations

#### **Participants:**


- 1. Understand and represent the interests of the Adopter organization that they represent, along with any relevant PMBC-related opportunities for their organization or barriers to PMBC adoption.
- 2. Actively participate in AWG meetings through attendance, discussion, and review of minutes, and other AWG-related documents.
- 3. Individual members may represent, or act as a proxy for, peer organizations by tabling questions or issues that are of common interest to a particular Adoption Group.
- 4. Take a genuine interest in the project's outcomes and overall success.

#### **Facilitators:**

- 1. Prepare and distribute AWG meeting agendas and related meeting materials in advance of each meeting.
- 2. Assist AWG participants in articulating issues, barriers and opportunities in an actionable way.
- 3. Ensure that AWG meetings are efficient and productive through exercising effective facilitation skills to ensure meeting agenda goals are achieved in the allocated time.
- 4. Clearly and succinctly summarize AWG meeting minutes, decisions and actions.

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
