

PMBC Adoption Working Group - Working Session #33 Summary Notes June 15, 2022 - 1:00 to 2:00pm - Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. Activities Since AWG #32 (March 30, 2022):
 - "Interest Parcels in ParcelMap BC" workshop April 6, 2021 72 attendees.
 - Basecamp AWG content has been migrated to LTSA's Help web site. Basecamp will be decommissioned over the summer. AWG content can now be found here: https://help.ltsa.ca/parcelmap-bc/adoption-working-group-summary-notes-and-slide-decks
 - Initiation of the development of a Customer Segment Market Strategy targeted at large LGs and large interest holders: transportation and utilities.
- 2. <u>Team Province ICF Retirement:</u> Operational retirement of the ICF is moving ahead using a phased approach to provide time for data consumers / applications to adapt. Key milestone dates are:
 - June 7, 2022: ParcelMap BC data is now available through the ICF views in the BCGW Test environment. ICF Layer files, stored in the BCGW Layer Library, and used in WMS and iMapBC, have been updated accordingly.
 - July 5, 2022: The ICF views in BCGW Production will be based solely on ParcelMap BC data.
 - March 1, 2023: Access to the ICF public view will be disabled.
 - September 1, 2024: Access to the ICF government view will be disabled.
- 3. <u>Team Province MoTI:</u> Peter Spry provided an overview of two key projects at MoTI that are related to ParcelMap BC:
 - Property Services Project to build a Property Information Management System
 - Property and Land Management Branch Scanning Project
- 4. <u>Team Alignment</u>: Esri Canada reported that a new version of the DAWp has been released. Highlights of the new release include:
 - New Realign Features tools.
 - Focus on scalability Fabric Shift QA procedure added. Fabric Shift method is now the "preferred" method for alignment and has been used successfully by Kelowna.
 - ArcGIS Desktop Versions supported: 10.6+
 - User guide significantly updated.







Fernie and the Cariboo RD are also currently using the DAWp and overall uptake of the Alignment Tools has been increasing.

- 5. <u>Planned Outreach Activities</u>: The following outreach activities are planned for the coming months:
 - LTSA attending LGMA in June. Engaging CAO's and other LG management.
 - LTSA attending MISA in late August.
 - Interior GIS User's Group --> Alison hosting a virtual event on July 20, with a

 - ICI Society may be back on the road in the Fall conducting various outreach activities.
