PMBC Adoption Working Group Steering Committee Working Session #36 Summary Notes

March 22, 2023 - 10:00 to 11:00am - Web Meeting

Summary of Key Session Findings / Outcomes:

- 1. <u>Consent Agenda Items</u>: The following Consent Agenda Items were approved by the group:
 - Agenda for AWG #36
 - Summary Notes from AWG #35
 - Review of Action Items from AWG #35
- 2. <u>Adoption Status Updates</u>: As of February 28, 2023 114 organisations have adopted ParcelMap BC.
- 3. <u>Team Province ICF Retirement</u>: The Province's plans regarding ICF retirement are continuing on schedule with retirement of the ICF Views (using ParcelMap BC data) now imminent.
- 4. <u>Team Province Other News:</u> MoTI has received their Adoption Certificate and are incorporating "Powered by ParcelMap BC" into their public facing messaging.
- <u>Team Alignment</u>: Province-wide alignment comparison of the ICI Cadastre & ParcelMap BC is currently in LTSA's backlog. A Province-wide assessment of the alignment of Canada Lands & ParcelMap BC is in discussion with NR Can. AWG participants showed a strong interest in the inclusion of Canada Lands (particularly internal divisions on reserves) in LTSA's ParcelMap BC Search Services application.
- 6. <u>Team Land Records:</u> No major activity or developments since the last AWG.
- 7. <u>Workshop/Presentations</u>: A Virtual Café/workshop on "Projections & Datums in use in BC" was led by Esri Canada on February 22, 2023. 56 people attended.
- 8. <u>Dissolution of the AWG</u>: After 4.5 years of activity the AWG has essentially achieved its original goals, including development of a comprehensive suite of adoption related resources that will continue to be curated and available to adopters. Going forward, LTSA will rely on an "advisory group" format to inform future direction for products and services development. As such, the AWG has effectively served its purpose and should be dissolved.

The motion to dissolve the AWG was raised by Brent Taylor, seconded by Jason Hart and approved by a majority vote of AWG participants.

This meeting marked the final formal session of the ParcelMap BC Adoption Working Group. The meeting adjourned with thanks to all participants - past and present!
