PARCELMAP BC ADOPTION WORKING GROUP

TERMS OF REFERENCE (September 24th 2018)

BACKGROUND

The ParcelMap BC Adoption Working Group (AWG) is comprised of representatives from multiple organisations interested in adopting ParcelMap BC plus a group of facilitators that will meet regularly during the course of the multi-year ParcelMap BC Adoption program. The goal of the AWG is to serve as a forum for adopter organisations to communicate with LTSA and the ICI Society concerning identification and resolution of barriers to the adoption of ParcelMap BC in their organization.

Adoption is defined as:

"ParcelMap BC is recognized and used as the authoritative cadastral parcel fabric representation in BC, spatially and for attribution, by the Adopter organizations, which include local governments and major utilities in the Province, among others."

The AWG will also serve as a means of identifying and facilitating and/or prioritizing the development of value-added products and services that the LTSA, ICI Society or others may provide to adopter organisations to enhance the value of ParcelMap BC over the longer term.

MEMBERSHIP

The AWG membership will be comprised of Participants and Facilitators fulfilling distinct roles.

Participants will include approximately 20 Adopter representatives, selected to adequately reflect the various and diverse interests of the following identified PMBC Adopter Groups:

Group 1A:	ICF to ParcelMap BC – Local Governments
Group 1B:	ICF to ParcelMap BC - Provincial Ministries and Agenci
Group 2:	Local Government Maintained to ParcelMap BC
Group 3:	ICI Society Cadastre to ParcelMap BC
Group 4:	Internal ICI Society to ParcelMap BC


